1. List the three main types of rocks.

• Igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks

2. Discuss how metamorphic rocks are formed.

• They are formed when chemical changes occur in igneous and sedimentary rocks which are under extreme heat and pressure.

3. Discuss the relationship among sand, silt and clay.

• When sand and clay are combined in equal proportions, loam is formed. However, if individual sand grains are coated in clay, then silt is formed.
