


LESSON NOTES

FOOD CHAINS

- The inter-dependence of organisms in an ecosystem can also be shown in **FOOD CHAINS**.
- A food chain shows what an organism eats and it is then a source of food for another organism.
- All food chains follow the general pattern shown below:



- A food chain always begins with a producer or plant and the direction of the arrow shows how the organism is being eaten.
- The following example describes the possible food chain that could take place in a flower garden
