

THE FLOWER:

- This is the main reproductive structure for all flowering plants
- The flowers have the female and male reproductive structures
- The female part is called the **PISTIL** and the male part of the flower is called the **STAMEN**
- The pistil contains the stigma, style and the ovary
- The ovary contains the eggs
- The stamen contains the filament and this holds the pollen sacs
- Pollen sacs contain pollen grains
