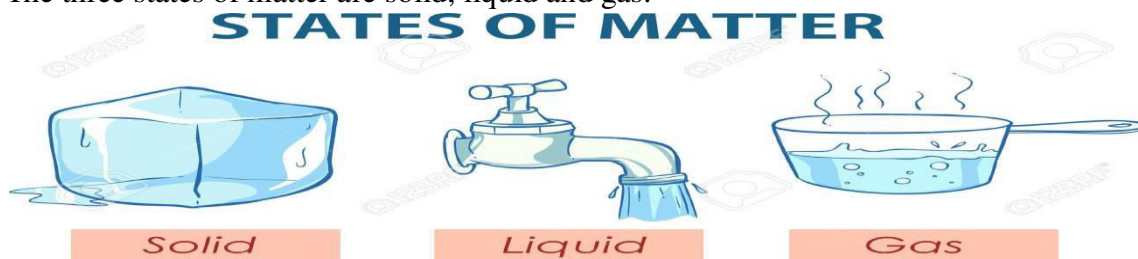
RHYME
