TOPIC: Observable features of plants

- ❖ Plants have special parts which have different functions that helps the plants to survive.
- ❖ Plants have stems, roots, flowers, fruits and leaves.
- ❖ Plants are different in color, size and shape.
- ❖ Different ways the features of plants help to survive.

Stem – able to support the plant, leaves, flowers.

Leaf - has green substance called chlorophyll that traps sunlight to make food for plants.

Root - holds the plants in the soil. Carries water through stem to leaves.

Flower - makes fruits.

Fruit - produces seeds.
