NOUNS

Proper nouns- are the names of particular people, places things or events.

A proper noun begins with a capital letter.

Examples: Fiji, Ana etc

Common nouns- nouns that are not the names of a particular person, places, things or event .

Examples: football, oil, pencil, river, sea etc

Collective nouns – these describe a group of people, animals or things.

Examples: a team of players, a bouquet of flowers, a herd of cattle.
