**Adjective**

- **Adjectives** are describing words. These words describe a noun.
- In the examples below, these adjectives are used to describe an elephant. Large elephant    Grey elephant    Friendly elephant
- Adjectives are of three types:
  1. **Positive adjectives** are usually written with “as” example John is as tall as Mary
  2. **Comparative adjectives** compare one noun to another example John is taller than Peter.
  3. **Superlative adjective** compare three or more nouns example, John is the tallest out of Peter and Mark.
