<u>Adjective</u>

- Adjectives are describing words. These words describe a noun.
- In the examples below, these adjectives are used to describe an elephant. <u>Large</u> elephant <u>Grey</u> elephant <u>Friendly</u> elephant
- Adjectives are of three types:
- 1. **Positive adjectives** are usually written with "as" example John is as <u>tall</u> as Mary
- 2. <u>**Comparative adjectives**</u> compare one noun to another example John is <u>taller</u> than Peter.
- 3. **Superlative adjective** compare three or more nouns example, John is the <u>tallest</u> out of Peter and Mark.
