Lesson Notes:

What is a prefix?

- A prefix is an affix which is placed before the stem of a word. Adding it to the beginning of one word changes it into another word.
- For example, when the prefix "un" is added to the word happy, it creates the word unhappy.
- Examples include:
 - 1. An answer that is not correct is an <u>in</u>correct answer. The prefix "in" is added to the root word: 'correct'
 - 2. An answer that is not complete is an <u>in</u>complete answer.
 - 3. Plans that are not yet definite are <u>in</u>definite plans.
- Some common examples of prefixes include:
