What is a pronoun?

- A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun.
- In the sentence: Joe saw Jill, and he waved at her, the pronouns he and her take the place of Joe and Jill respectively.
- Examples of pronouns include:

I	You	She	We	They
Me	Your	His	Us	Them
My	He	Her	Our	Their
It	Himself	Herself	Yourselves	Themselves
