How to make: SCRAMBLED EGGS

Serves: 4 people

Ingredients:

- 8 eggs
- ½ cup of milk
- 2 tablespoons of butter
- Salt and pepper

Cooking Direction

- 1. Break the eggs in a bowl, whisk them for about 1 minute.
- 2. Heat a pan on a stove. Add 2 tablespoons of butter to the pan.
- 3. Pour the eggs into the hot pan. Add ½ cup of milk to the eggs.
- 4. Mix the eggs and milk for about 4-5 minutes, until the eggs are cooked.
- 5. Add salt and pepper
- 6. Optional: you can add chilli sauce, fresh herbs or grated cheese on your eggs.
