Study the resource below and use your knowledge to answer the question below.

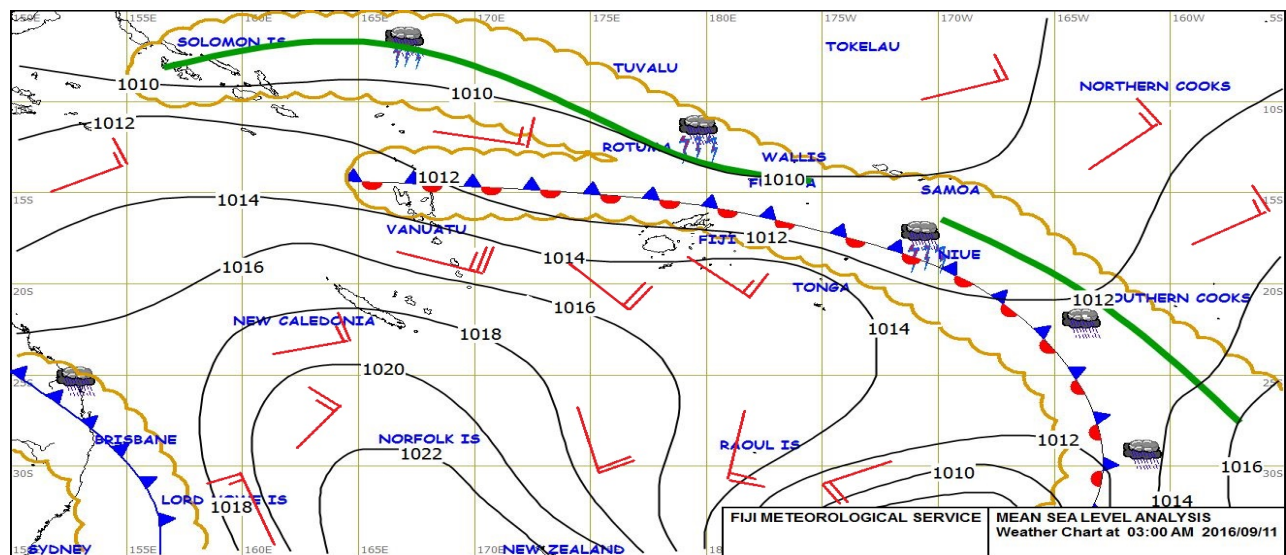


State **two** ways by which the people who are affected in the resource could be assisted by the government.
