Conjunction

A conjunction is a word that is used to connect words, phrases and clauses. Some common conjunctions are: and, or, but, because, for, if and when.

Examples of Conjunctions in a sentence:

- I tried to hit the nail **but** hit my thumb instead.
- I have two goldfish **and** a cat.
- I'd like a bike **for** commuting to work.
- You can have peach ice cream **or** a brownie sundae.
- Neither the black dress **nor** the grey one looks right on me.
- My dad always worked hard **so** we could afford the things we wanted.

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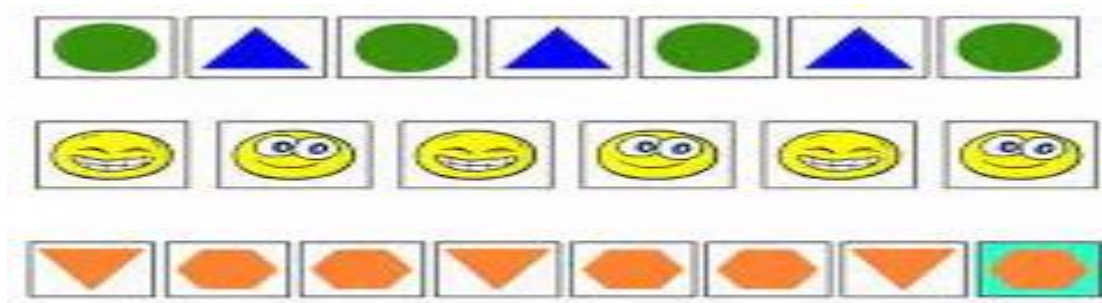

Energy Sources

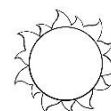
What is Energy?

1. Energy is the ability to do work. It is the power.
2. Energy takes form
3. Heat, light and sound are forms of energy

Sources of Energy

1. Sun

- Energy that comes from the sun is called **Solar Energy**
- Solar energy is clean and free.
- We use **solar panels** to get energy from the sun.
- We can not get this energy on a cloudy day and at night



2. Water

- Water energy is called **Hydro Power**.
- It is free and clean
- A dam is built for water flow.



3. Wind

- Wind mills are used to create energy from wind
- It is free
- Wind mills need strong wind to work.



4. Wave power

- Wave energy is energy produced from the wave of the ocean.
- Wave are formed by wind moving across the surface of the ocean.



5. Fossil Fuel

- Fuels such as kerosene, benzene and gas are used everyday
- Commonly used in Fiji houses
- It is very expensive



6. Biomass

- Is a plant or animal material used as fuel to produce electricity or heat. Example: wood, energy crops, waste from forest, yards or farms.
