



Topic: Time

- 1. A clock face has:
- a. numbers 1-12 in order around the clock.
- b. there is a long hand and a short hand.
 - The <u>long hand</u> is called the <u>minute hand</u>
 The <u>short hand</u> is called the <u>hour hand</u>.
- c. There are 60 minutes in 1 hour.





- ➤ If the minute hand is moving from 12 down to 6 we say its ____ minutes past ____ [say the number that the hour hand has passed]
- > If the minute hand is moving from 6 up to 12- we say its ____ minutes to ____ [say the next number which the hour hand is moving towards.]
 - For example:
- If the minute hand points at 12 and the hour hand points at 1, we say 1 o'clock
 - ❖ We write it as: its 1 o'clock or 1.00 and so on.
- ➤ If the minute hand points at 3, we say it's a quarter past 1
 - ❖ We write it as: it's a quarter past 1 or 1.15.
- ➤ If the minute hand points at 6, we say it's half past 1
 - ❖ We write it as its **half past 1** or **1.30**
- ➤ If the minute hand points at 9, we say it's a quarter to
 - ❖ We write it as it's a quarter to 2 or 1.45

Example: What is the time?



It's a quarter past 2 or 2.15



It's a quarter to 12 or 11.45




It's 3 o'clock or 3.00



Its half past 9 or 9.30
