UNIT 6: THE HUMAN DIGESTIVE SYSTEM

- The human digestive system is a complex series of organs and glands that processes food.
- Most of the digestive organs are tube-like and contain the food as it makes its way through the body.
- The digestive system is essentially a long, twisting tube that runs from the mouth to the anus.
- The digestive process begins in the **mouth** and ends in the **small intestine**.
- Food is partly broken down by the process of chewing and by the chemical action called **enzymes.**
- Food then enters the oesophagus (food pipe) to the stomach.
- The stomach is a large, sac-like organ that churns the food bathes it in a very strong acid.



TAKING CARE OF OUR DIGESTIVE SYSTEM

- Eat a high fibre diet/ roughage to prevent constipation. Examples of foods are fruits and vegetables.
- Limit foods that are high in fat.
- Choose lean meats.
- Eat on schedule
- > Drinking plenty of water
- > Exercise regularly.
