Lesson Notes

Rounding Off Numbers to the nearest 10:

When we round off to the nearest ten we look at the ones. If it is 5 or more, we round it up but when it is 4 or less we round it down. Example: 26(26 is in between 20 and 30)

20 <u>26</u> 30

6 is more than 5 so round it up to 30

Rounding Off Numbers to the nearest 100:

When we round off to the nearest hundred we look at the tens and ones. If it is 50 or more, we round it up but when it is 49 or less we round it down. Example: 127(127 is in between 100 and 200)

100 127 200

27 is less than 50 so we round it down to 100
