### **Ordering Numbers**

1. Numbers have an order or arrangement.
2. The order can be ascending or descending.
3. **Ascending order** – the numbers are arranged from smallest to biggest.  
**Examples:**
  - a. 2798, 4908, 5990, 7059, 7874, 9237
  - b. 39467, 40239, 48667, 53630, 57803, 65435
4. **Descending order** – the numbers are arranged from biggest to smallest.  
**Examples:**
  - a. 6041, 5041, 4041, 3041, 2041, 1041
  - b. 876504, 739973, 609278, 561209, 490824, 398043
