Hair cutting ceremony in the Hindu Community

- ▶ Hair cutting ceremony in Hindu ceremony is called <u>Mundan.</u>
- > Believed to give long life and good future to the child.
- > Thought to be essential to protect the child from evil eye.
- > Performed during the first year or the third year of a child's life.
- > The hair is usually cut by a senior member of the child's family/

In some groups Mundan is done only for a baby boy, however depending on the beliefs and customs of the family, girls too may have a Mundan ceremony.
