

Cook Islands

- 1. Migrants from French Polynesia are believed to have arrived on the Southern island group around 800 AD.
- 2. The Northern islands were settled by expeditions from Samoa and Tonga.
- 3. The Cook Islands Maori language is closely related to the Te Reo Maori indigenous language of New Zealand.
- 4. The country is named after Captain James Cook who surveyed and landed on some of the islands between 1774 and 1777.
- 5. The capital of this country is **Rarotonga**.
