A Preposition is a word that relates a Noun or a Pronoun to another word in the sentence, often by describing where it is or where it is moving towards.

Example

Maca + climbed + the ladder = Maca climbed <u>up</u> the ladder.The boy + fell + a hole = The boy fell <u>into</u> a hole.Words that are used to connect other words like this are called Prepositions.


