WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN NATURAL AND ARTIFICIAL MATERIAL?

Natural Material

• Natural materials are things that are produced by nature, not made by men.

Biotic Materials

• Wood-rattan, bamboo, bark, etc. • Natural fibres- wool, cotton, flax, moss, etc.

Inorganic Materials

- Stone-flint, granite, sand, etc.
- Metal-copper, bronze, iron, silver, etc.

Composites

• clay, porcelain, plasticine, etc

Artificial Material

• Artificial Materials are made by humans, especially in imitation of something natural: **Examples: Plastics, clothes, paper**.
