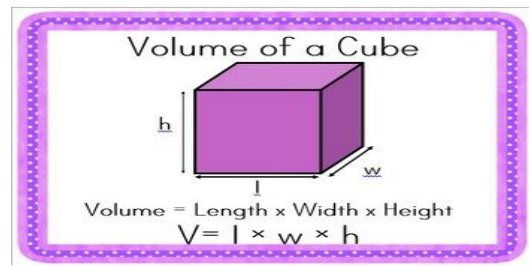
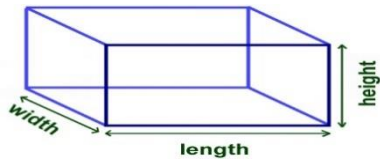

**VOLUME** – The amount of space a solid figure takes up.

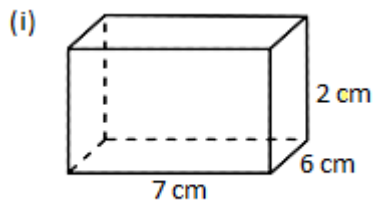
The base unit for measuring volume is cubic centimeter ( $\text{cm}^3$ ).



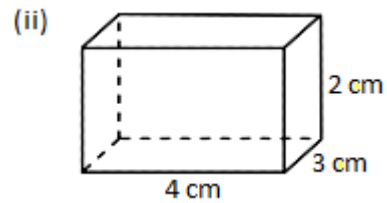

**Biotic Materials**

- Wood-rattan, bamboo, bark, etc. • Natural fibres- wool, cotton, flax, moss, etc.

**Inorganic Materials**

- Stone-flint, granite, sand, etc.
- Metal-copper, bronze, iron, silver, etc.

**Composites**

- clay, porcelain, plasticine, etc

**Artificial Material**

- Artificial Materials are made by humans, especially in imitation of something natural:  
**Examples: Plastics, clothes, paper.**
