

(a)




$$\text{Perimeter} = (\text{length} + \text{width}) \times 2$$

$$\begin{aligned} &= (10+5) \times 2 \\ &= 15 \times 2 \end{aligned}$$

Perimeter = **30cm**

(b)



$$\text{Perimeter} = (\text{length} + \text{width}) \times 2$$

$$\begin{aligned} &= (15+6) \times 2 \\ &= 21 \times 2 \end{aligned}$$

Perimeter = **42cm**
