





$$\begin{aligned} A &= \frac{1}{2} \times b \times h \\ &= \frac{1}{2} \times 4\text{cm} \times 3\text{cm} \\ &= \frac{4\text{cm} \times 3\text{cm}}{2} \\ &= 2\text{cm} \times 3\text{cm} \end{aligned}$$

$$A = 6\text{cm}^2$$

$$\begin{aligned} A &= L \times W \\ &= 6\text{cm} \times 2\text{cm} \\ A &= 12\text{cm}^2 \end{aligned}$$

  - a. **Wipe your outer ear with a damp washcloth daily when washing your face or taking a shower.**
  - b. **Avoid putting anything into your ears, including cotton swabs, tweezers or sharp objects.**  
**Pushing objects into your ears may damage or rupture your ear drum.**
  - c. **Have your ear checked regularly by a doctor, and learn the warning signs of hearing loss.**
