LESSON NOTES

Electoral system used from Independence to the Present.

<u>First Post the Post</u>-The candidate who received the highest number of votes is declared the winner. <u>Alternative Vote System</u>- This system, allows the votes to be transferred from a low-polling candidate to other candidates, according to an order prescribed by the candidate.

Proportional Representation System

- In this system, voters may be given choice of the number of a candidate they may vote for deeding the type of system used.

Political Conditions

-Post-independence politics came to be dominated by Ratu Sir Kamisese Mara and the Alliance Party.

Coups:

1987- In April 1987, Dr. Bavadra was forcibly removed from power during a military coup led by Sitiveni Rabuka on 14 May 1987. Rabuka staged a second coup on 25 September 1987.

2000- Chaudhry's government was removed by ethnic Fijian nationalist George Speight, on 19 May 2000.

2006- the military leader Commodore Frank Bainimarama asked Prime Minister Laisenia Qarase to resign in mid-October, 2006.

Effects of coups:-

- Decline in the investment loss of jobs, less tourist arrivals due to insecurity in Fiji,
- decline in trade and poor link with foreign nations.
- increase in crime mental stress and fear among community,
- Leads to brain drain
