

Clauses

What is a clause?

A clause is a group of words that contains a subject and a verb that have a relationship.

Types of Clauses



Independent Clause

An independent clause is a clause that can stand on its own as a distinct sentence. Take a look at these examples:

- I love eating cookies.
- My dog barks a lot.
- The kids ate lunch.
- His truck is green.

Dependent Clause

Dependent clauses are sometimes known as <u>subordinate clauses</u>. As their name implies, these clauses depend on independent clauses to clearly express ideas. Here are a few examples of dependent clauses:

When I grow up

Although he sings well
