Lesson Notes

The plural of a noun typically denotes a quantity greater than the default quantity represented by that noun. This default quantity is most commonly one. * Singular means one.

**In given to words PLUPALS mean more than one of a certain noun (naming word)

* In simple words PLURALS mean more than one of a certain noun (naming word).

Rule 1: Rule 2:

To write the plurals of most nouns we usually add letter "_s" at the end of the word.

Example: 1 girl - 2 girls 1 eye - 2 eyes To write the plurals of nouns ending with these letters- s, h, o, and x, we usually put the letters "_es" at the end of the word. (Except for some nouns ending with 'x' that have 'x' removed and "_ces" added to make the plurals).

Example: 1 dress - 2 dress<u>es</u> 1 mango - 2 mango<u>es</u>

To write sentences for plural form of verbs: we use "These are ..." and not "This is ..."
