Step 1: Harvest Coconut Leaves

Using a craft knife, remove the stick running at middle of the fronds

Now you have 2 leaflets from one frond



Step 2: Start Weaving

Place required number of leaflets side by side on the floor (9, 10 or 11 to the required size)

Take another leaflet and weave through leaflets on the floor in an above and below pattern



Step 3: Folding Extra Length

If you look at the partly woven mat at this stage, you will find the extra length of leaves in an above and below position

First take the leaflets at one side which are below and fold them over the end leaf

Insert the folded portion through other leaflets in the same pattern as above and below

Trim end of leaflets that is coming out.



Step 4: Repeat Folding on Other Side

Now turn over the mat and repeat same we did on the other side, like folding extra length and inserting ends through the leaflets

Trim all extra length of leaflets and our mat is finished






