

People and Work



<u>Unpaid work</u>- work we do at home like washing dishes and feeding the pigs. Paid work- we get salary or wages for doing work.

### Different types of Work

- 1. <u>Casual workers</u> people only work when there is work to be done and the workers are paid as soon as the work is completed.
- 2. <u>Temporary Workers</u> these workers usually work for a period of time and depending on the contract they sign before they begin to work.
- 3. <u>Permanent Workers</u>- these workers continue working until they retire from their work.
- 4. <u>Voluntarily Workers</u> these workers are not paid for the work they do but provide their services free of charge in our communities.

*Wages*- paid hourly daily or weekly.

Salary- fixed amount earned in a year. Example- are teachers, doctors, nurses, police

**Employer**- a person or company which provides job to people.

*Employee-* a person who is hired to do the work.

#### The Value of Our Currency (\$)

Fiji currency (money) does not have the same value with other currencies of other countries. In some countries our currency in much stronger and others it might be weaker.

#### **Families Financial Commitments**

Parents work so that they earn an income. Our financial commitment will depend on the goods and services that we use daily at home. For example,

we need to pay for electricity bills, buy our groceries and pay for bus fares.

A *budget* should be prepared to plan our expense.



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
