# LESSON 1/2: SELECTING PLANTING MATERIAL/SELECTING THE SOURCE OF THE PLANTING MATERIAL

**Learning Outcomes**: At the end of this lesson the student will:

- i. determine the type of planting material to use for selected crops
- ii. select suitable planting material for the propagation of a crop

### **Notes:**

Most crops may be propagated using more than one type of planting material

Farmers can usually get planting material from more than one source. Farmers carefully compare the sources before selecting where to get the planting material from.

The farmer must ensure the source of the planting material is:

- i) reputable has a record of providing quality planting material at a fair price.
- ii) accessible the farmer can reach the supplier without too much cost or effort.
- iii) reliable provides the same quality and quantity of planting material when the farmer needs it.
