Lesson Notes – Is all water the same

- As rain water runs through rocks and filters through soil, different minerals are dissolved in it.
- Water from the sea, stream or river often, has water from homes and factories entering
- Minerals dissolved in water particularly affect the way soap reacts with water
- Water which does not usually lather with soap is called hard water
- Water which lathers with soap is called soft water

Activity 1 Comparing water

Which water is best for washing?

Material

- Equal amount of different types of water-rain water ,sea water, tap water
- Equal amount of same soap

Method

- Equal volume of different types of water were placed into 3 test tubes and equal volume of soap(5 drops)was added to each test-tubes
- The test-tubes were stoppered and shaken 10 times each
- If lather did not form, another drop of soap was added and shaken 10 times. This was repeated until lather formed in each test-tube
- The number of drops of soap added in each test-tube was recorded

Results

Types of water	Drops of soap added to give	Observation
	lather	
Rain water	5	Forms ,a thick lather upon shaking
Tap water	7	Forms a thick lather upon shaking

Sea water	20	Does not form lather a white scum is

Conclusion

- Sea water is the hardest water
- Rain water is the softest water
- When soap is shaken with hard water scum forms

Activity 2 Reaction with detergents

Material

- Equal amounts of water samples-rain water, tap water and sea water
- Equal amounts of same detergent

Method

- Same amount of water was placed in the test tubes
- Same amount of detergent was added to all three types of water
- Each test-tube was shaken 10 times and observation was recorded

Results

- It was seen that lather formed in all types of water
- It can be said that, detergents lather with all types of water.
