| Country | Wheat | Clothes |
|---------|-------|---------|
| A | 100 | 110 |
| В | 60 | 150 |

Absolute Advantage – Just look at the number which is the highest.

Wheat- Country A

Clothes- Country B

Comparative Advantage - Will require us to do some calculations. The nation with the <u>lowest opportunity cost</u> will have the comparative advantage in producing that commodity.

Wheat

| Country A | Country B |
|-----------|-----------|
| 110/100 | 150/60 |
| 1.1 | 2.5 |

So Country A has the comparative advantage in producing wheat

Clothes

| Country A | Country B |
|-----------|-----------|
| 100/110 | 60/150 |
| 0.91 | 0.4 |

So Country B has the comparative advantage in producing clothes
