**Act 2 :
Scene 4: Iva is Cured**

Plot

Tonu comes on Sunday evening with Ilai and Tupou. Atama is very worried because Iva's condition had worsened. Atama admits that he trusts in Ilai's powers. Iva comes and Ilai prays for her. After the prayer, Iva collapses. Ilai tells Atama that his wife is cured and needed rest. Atama is to keep Iva happy. Ilai is not sure about the fate of the unborn child.

Activity

1. After listening to the dialogues read by selected students;

- Recall and tell whatever has been mentioned about Ilai.

- Discuss why Ilai does not charge for his service.

2. Why do you think Ilai wants total trust from Atama before he could cure Iva?

3. In short sentences, explain whatever has happened to Iva in the last few days as described by Atama (pages 47-48).

Act 3

Scene 1: Iva's Delivery

Plot

Iva has recovered. She is worried about buying things for the baby. She asks Atama how he would react if the child is deformed and Atama replies that he would accept it. Atama's aunt, Selina comes. She is in charge of Iva's delivery. Iva is in labour pain and Atama gets excited. He wants to be with Iva but Selina tells him to wait outside.

Activity

1. Note Iva's speech at the beginning of this scene. How can you interpret from her speech that she is worried about something?

2. Express your opinion on whether you think the father of the child should be allowed to be with his wife during delivery.

3. Why was Iva worried at the beginning of the scene?

4. If you were in place of Atama, what advice you would have given to Iva?
