Traditional Dress

- In the past, the length of the grass skirt depended on their marital status for most womanshort for single women and long for married women. Girls then wore virgin locks up until their marriage and usually had tattoos covering their lower regions (seen as a sign of beauty).
- Today, women dress more conventionally usually wearing masi or tapa cloth for mekes or weddings.
