- \succ The <u>two numbers</u> that we add are called <u>addends</u>.
- > The **answer** we get after adding is called the **sum**.
- > Addition increases the total number of objects.
- > The sum we get after adding the two numbers is always **<u>bigger</u>** than the two numbers that we add.






