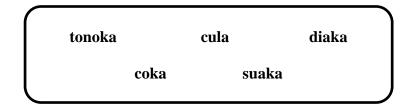

Lesson Notes Rainbow

Did you know that the sun's light is really made up of the seven colors in the rainbow? It is true. When all the colors are mixed together they give off what is called white light. The colours are:

- Red
- Orange
- Yellow
- Green
- Blue
- Indigo (navy blue)
- Violet (purple)

An easy way to remember the colors of the rainbow is ROY G BIV. A rainbow occurs when it is raining in one part of the sky and sunny in another.
