Topic: Sundials

The shadow created by the sunlight can be used to tell the time. Sundials are the oldest known instruments for telling time. The surface of a sundials has markings for each hour of daylight. As the sun moves across the sky, another part of the sundial casts a show on these markings. The positions of the shadow show what time it is.





<u>The Sun</u> – it started to form over four and a half billion years ago. The center, or core, of the Sun is very hot. Some energy travels out into space as heat and light. Without the sun, most plants and animals would not survive. Plants use the sun's energy to make their own food and to grow. So without sunlight there would be no life on earth.


