Content Learning Outcome	Use operations to calculate value of time in hours and minutes

Activity

1. Sam spent 1hr 55min in his garden on Saturday and 2hr 50min on Sunday. How many hours and minutes did he spend in his garden altogether in these two days?

Add the minutes: 55min + 50min = 105 min

Divide 105 by 60 to get number of hours and minutes:

$$\begin{array}{r} 1R45 \\ 60 \overline{)105} \\ \underline{-60} \\ 45 \end{array}$$

The number before the remainder represents hours and the number after the remainder represents minutes i.e. 1hr 45min

Add the hours: 1hr + 2hr + 1hr = 4 hours

Put the hours and minutes together: 4 hours 45 minutes

He spent 4 hours 45 minutes in the garden.

2. A bus travelled from Rakiraki to Tavua in 50 mins and from Tavua to Ba in 35 mins. How long was the trip from Rakiraki to Ba?

Add the minutes: 50min + 35min = 85 min

Divide 85 by 60 to get number of hours and minutes:

$$\begin{array}{r} 1R25 \\ 60 \overline{)85} \\ \underline{-60} \\ 25 \end{array}$$

This means 85 minutes is the same as 1 hour and 25 minutes.

The trip was 1 hour 25 minutes long.

3. Jenna went for a 5 hour boat trip. If she has travelled for 3hr 25 min, how much time does she have left for completing the trip?

Convert both times to minutes:

$$5 \times 60 = 300 \text{ min}$$

$$(3 \times 60) + 25\text{min} = 180 \text{ min} + 25 \text{ min} = 205 \text{ min}$$

Subtract:

$$\begin{array}{r} 291 \\ \cancel{300} \text{ min} \\ \underline{-205 \text{ min}} \\ 95 \text{ min} \end{array}$$

Divide 95 min by 60 to change it to hours and minutes:

$$\begin{array}{r} 1R35 \\ 60 \overline{)95} \\ \underline{-60} \\ 35 \end{array}$$

She has 1 hour and 35 minutes left for completing the trip.

Put the dry twigs together and light it up. Put the piece of bread in the fire.

You will observe that the dried twig easily catches fire and slowly turns to ashes. Also, the bread burns, turning the color to black and becoming hard.
