- 1. Reasons why a person stops breathing:
 - \checkmark Electrocuted.
 - \checkmark Poisoned.
 - \checkmark Has an injury to his chest.
 - \checkmark Drowned.
- 2. Rescue breathing. Rescue breathing is a **skill performed for a victim who is not breathing at all**, or whose breaths are too slow or irregular to be effective.

In rescue breathing, breaths are delivered to the victim by pinching the nose shut and breathing into the victim's mouth. This is done to deliver oxygen to the victim to help their brain.

- 3. **Choking** is when a person has severe difficulty in breathing because of a constricted or obstructed throat or a lack of air.
- 4. **First aid** is the help given to a sick or injured person until full medical treatment is available.
- 5. First aid is important when a person has stopped breathing to prevent brain damage and death.
