

Tuesday is mail day for us. We don't have a road into our place in the Marlborough sounds, so our mail comes to us by boat. Our mail boat, the 'Glenmore', runs from the nearest part of Havelock. It won't be back until half past five in the afternoon. After we wave goodbye to the 'Glenmore' and its passengers, we wander off up to the house and make a cup of tea before opening our mail bag. Mail day is like a Sunday for us. We spend most of the morning reading letters from our families and friends and catching up on the week's newspaper. But most of all, we enjoy looking through our library books which we order from the 'Books by mail 'service in Christchurch. Mail day is our favorite day of the week.




