

Cyclones

Cyclones are tropical¹ storms that start in the ocean waters near the equator.² The storm moves its way north where the air is cooler. The wind gets stronger and the rain gets heavier. The “eye of the storm” is located in the center of the storm. It is the storm’s calmest part. There is no rain in the eye and it can spread across 20 miles. The winds around the eye can blow as much as 200 miles per hour and is the strongest. They have the ability to uproot trees from of the ground. They can also blow glass out of windows.

In the Pacific Islands, November – April is the Cyclone season. Every new season, tropical cyclones are labelled. The names follow alphabetical order, and alternate between male and female names. For example, the first hurricane may be Hurricane Bibi, Eric, Evan, Kina, Luci, etc.

Hurricanes can last up to 14 days long. They travel for thousands of miles across the ocean. Most of the time they never reach the coast, but when they do hit the coast, conditions become very dangerous. When water levels rise, there can be floods and *mudslides*.³ Houses close to the shore can be wiped out, and the people who live there can be in grave danger. When the hurricane is over, the conditions are worst leaving victims with no water, food supply, no electricity, homes and even death to the loved ones. Therefore we need to take *precautionary* measures to be safe

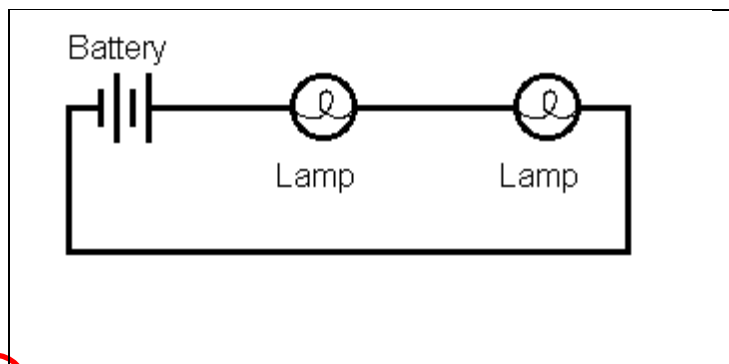
