Work out:

1. $\$80 \times 3 = \240
2. 4 pairs = 8 bullocks. $\$300 \times 8 = \2400
3. $94 \times 4 = 376 + 98 = 474/5 = 94.8$
4. $86 \times 3 = 258 + 90 + 80 = 428/5 = 85.6$
5. speed = distance / time $476/4 = 119\text{km/h}$
6. distance = speed x time $82 \times 5.25 = 430.5\text{km}$
7. $\$12.95/7 = \$1.85/\text{kg} \times 3 = \5.55
8. CP – SP = Loss $\$6100 - \$4500 = \$1600$

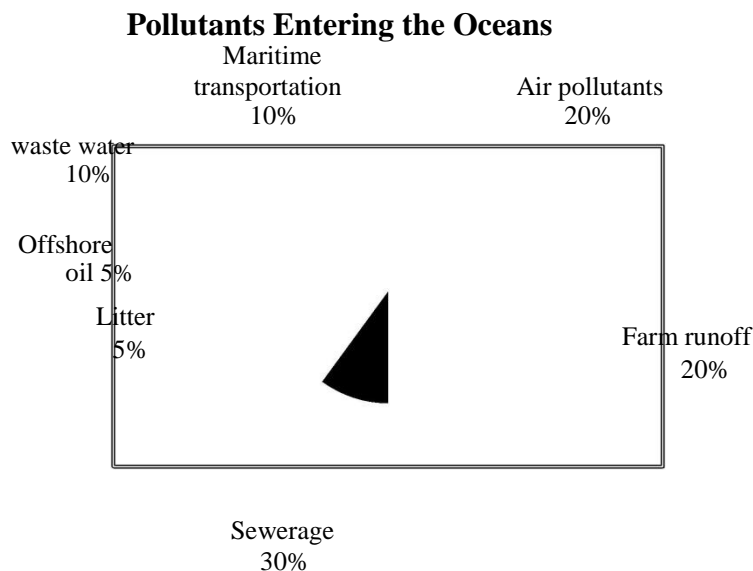
