

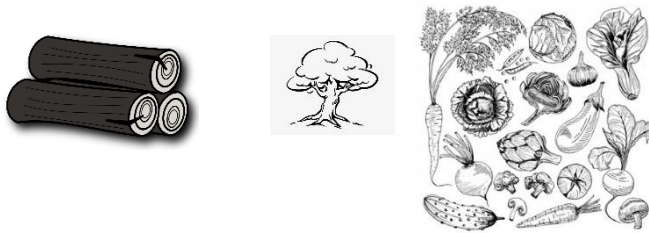

<b>CONTENT LEARNING OUTCOME</b>	Recognise that the physical world is made up of natural and synthetic (man made) materials with a variety of physical properties.

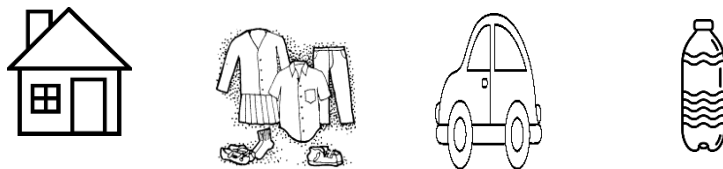
**LESSON NOTES**

**Natural and Man Made Material**

**Natural Material:** comes from our natural environment (plants, animals, land, sea).  
 Example: trees, leaf, bones, feathers, wood, soil.



**Man Made (Synthetic) Material:** are made in the factory. They are processed materials.  
 Example: glass, pipe, bottle, nail, tin, kitchen utensils, plastics.
