**Hair cutting ceremony in an i-Taukei community**

- This ceremony is usually done for a baby boy only in the i-taukei culture.
- The hair cutting is normally done by a close relative of the baby.
- The child is usually wrapped in a tapa to signify the special occasion.
- A special feast is normally prepared by the family after the hair cutting ceremony is over.
