Pronouns are words that replaces the Nouns

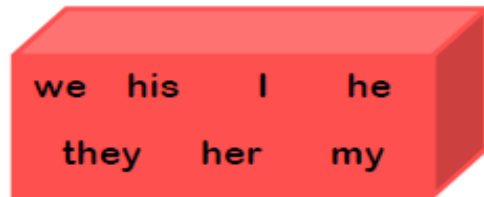
For example: *Tevita washed Tevita's hair. Tevita washed **his** hair.*
