



Topic: Forces

- 1. Forces are pushes, pulls and twist.
- 2. Things move in many ways.
- 3. They slide and glide, they twist and turn, they rise and fall and some things move quickly while others slowly.
- 4. Forces make things move.
- 5. We push, pull or twist with the help of our muscles.
- 6. Sometimes we use machines to help us.
- 7. Forces are all around you. You cannot see forces.
- 8. You can only see what forces can do.

Examples of each kind of force

Push – move something away	Pull – move something closes	Twist – makes something move in a circle
Using wheel borrows for heavy objects	Taking out clothes from drawers	Turning the top on
Using trolley for shopping	Taking out water from well	Opening the water bottle
