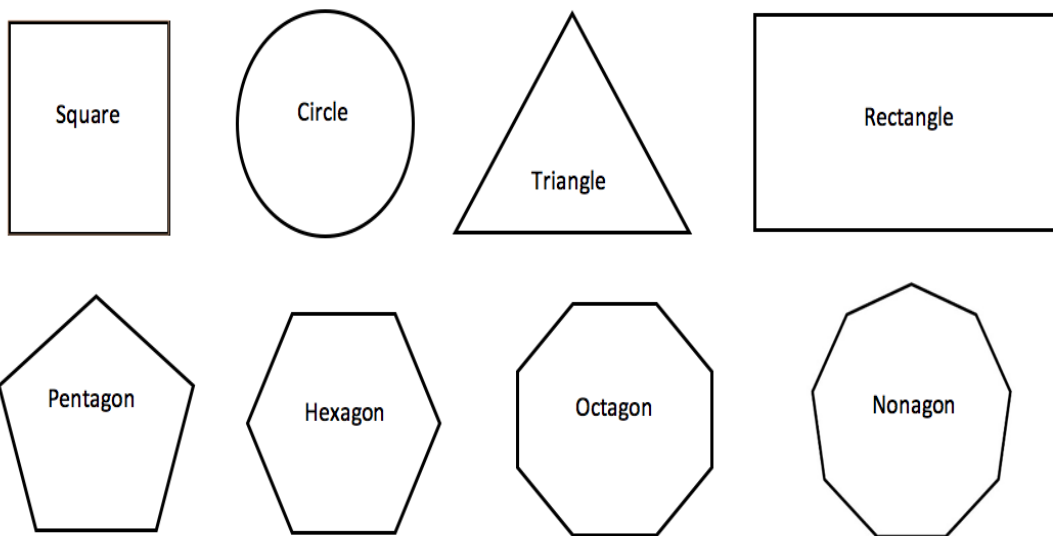

Conservation

Conservation is using things or resources wisely so there are no wastage.

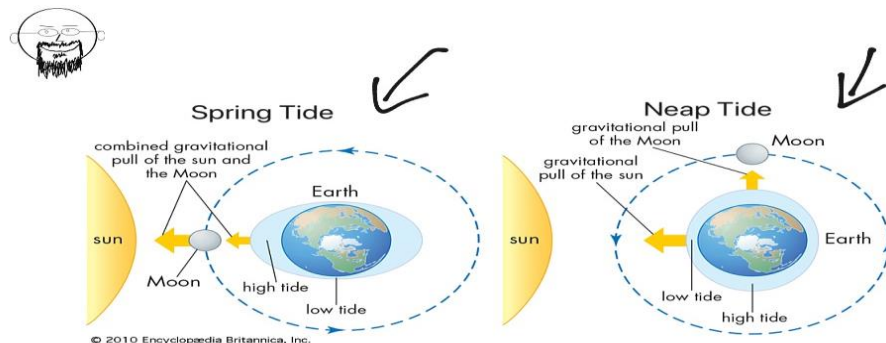

Lesson Notes:

Tides

- Tides are alternate rising and falling of the sea. These are caused by the Moon and Sun.
- This is clearly shown by the Spring and Neap tides. The Moon causes tides.
- The phases of the Moon and the Earth's tides are determined by the positions of the three bodies: Earth, the Moon and the Sun.
- The ocean tides are caused by the gravitational pull of both the Sun and the Moon. However because it is closer to Earth, **the Moon's gravitational influence is greater than the Sun's.**
- The oceans rise up and fall back twice everyday due to the Moon's gravitational pull.
- The highest tides will occur when the Moon, Earth and Sun are lined up and where the pull on the oceans is stronger. These highest tides are called spring tides.
- When the Sun and the Moon are pulling at right angles to each other, the high tides will be lower. These moderate tides are known as neap tides.
