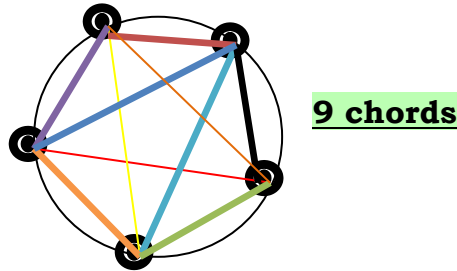

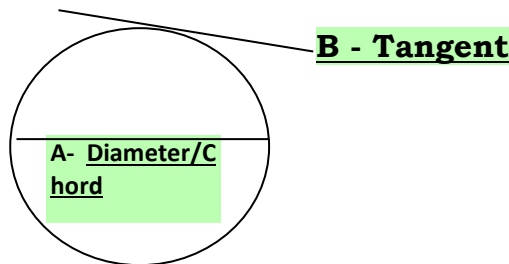
1. Aryan scored 480 marks in 5 subjects. What is his average mark?

7. The wheel of a bicycle measures  $70\text{cm}$  in diameter. How far does the wheel travel when it turns round twice? (Use  $\pi = 3.14$ )

$$\begin{aligned} C &= \pi d \\ &= 3.14 \times 70 \times 2 \\ &= \mathbf{439.6\text{cm}} \end{aligned}$$
